

RULES AND REGULATIONS -- CLUB PROPERTY

FAMILY MEMBER POLICY

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of Cape George Colony Club to treat family members **residing** in member's homes in a just and fair manner; and

WHEREAS the Dedication and Restrictions for Cape George Colony state "All lots, tracts or parcels embraced in this plat are subject to and shall be sold under the following covenants and restrictions, which shall run with the land for the benefit of each lot, tract or parcel in this plat, and shall be binding on all purchasers and owners thereof and their personal representatives, heirs, successors and assigns ...", and

WHEREAS Article I (2) of the Bylaws defines a member as "Owner of a Lot or Lots included in the real property described in the attached Exhibit "A" or the surviving spouse or heirs of such owner.", and

WHEREAS Article II, Section (3) of the Articles of Incorporation authorize the Board of Trustees to "to make rules, regulations, interpretations, decisions and enforce decisions and determinations, pertaining to covenants and restrictions" ; thus

HEREBY, the Board of Trustees establishes the following policy:

Family members **residing** within Cape George Colony Club have all the rights accorded to the legal owner, such as use of all Club facilities, attend all Cape George Functions, be listed in the official telephone book, be members of committees, and run for the Board of Trustees. Renters are specifically excluded from these rights.
