

RULES AND REGULATIONS -- USE OF CLUB PROPERTY

ACCESS TO COMMONLY OWNED CLUB FACILITIES BY NON-MEMBERS

(Guests and visiting Adult Family Members)

GUEST: A member in good standing may host one or more “guests” at commonly owned Club facilities. A “guest” is a non-family individual visiting Club property at the invitation of a member. The host member must remain with his/her guest(s) at all times while on Club property.

FAMILY MEMBERS: A member in good standing may provide access to the Club facilities by a visiting adult family member (over 18 years) to enable this individual to have unaccompanied access to the Club facilities with an approved “Adult Family Member Pass” obtained in the office.

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITY: The host member is responsible for assuring that the guest or family member follows the rules pertaining to the use of the particular Club facility. The host member shall be liable for the conduct of his/her guests or family members. A member’s privileges to use the Club facilities or to provide access to such facilities for guests or family members may be limited or forfeited, and penalties and/or damage claims may be assessed against a host member for their misconduct.
