

RULES AND REGULATIONS -- USE OF CLUB PROPERTY

UNAUTHORIZED DISPOSAL

The purpose of this regulation is to place upon all persons in Cape George the duty of contributing to community cleanliness and appearance and to protect all residents from unsanitary and unsightly conditions and to further protect the community from expenses incurred due to littering.

No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited anywhere within the limits of Cape George, including the beach, any waste material including but not limited to disposable packages or containers, brush, straw, hay, manure, boards, papers, ashes, stones, vegetables or any rubbish of any nature, nor shall such materials be deposited in any community garbage can or receptacle with the exception of materials from authorized community activities.

All personal household waste materials stored on individually owned properties must be in proper closed garbage receptacles, except that bagged wastes may be placed at the road side on garbage pick up day and these must be removed if not picked up and are the responsibility of the owner.
