

Family Swim Procedures Cape George Pool

WELCOME TO THE POOL CAPE GEORGE FAMILIES!!!

Some things you need to know before you schedule a swim:

1. The pool is available for Cape George Members only.
Family Swim times are available as follows:
Tuesdays at 3 pm and 5 pm, Thursday 3 pm and 5 pm,
Saturdays at 10 am, 1 pm and 3 pm. Monitors need one hour
to sanitize after each scheduled swim.
2. Only 1 Cape George Family at a time can reserve swim
times. All must be Members of the same household.
No guests/friends including family who does not live in the
same household are permitted. No outside family or friends
are currently allowed.
3. A trained Monitor must be present for Family Swim sessions.
(The trained Monitor can be an adult Family member.)
Training will be conducted by Penny Jensen.
4. A Parent(s)/Grandparent(s)/Guardian(s) living in the same
household must accompany all children in the pool area, and
they must remain in the pool area for the entire scheduled
time. Bring your own toys for the pool.
5. It is recommended that all swimmers shower before they
come to the pool.
6. Swim diapers are required for children not potty trained.
7. Changing Rooms are closed. The restroom outside the pool
is open.

8. Family members must wear masks to enter the pool area. All will be asked COVID protocol questions and temperatures will be taken. If a Member has a temperature greater than 99.4, they will not be permitted to enter the pool.
9. Benches are available to put towels, clothes, etc.
10. At the conclusion of the 1-hour swim, Members must exit the pool, replace their mask(s) and leave the building.
11. Monitors must sanitize any surface that was touched during the Family swim and follow the same Protocol sanitation procedures as those used by Adult Lap Swim Monitors. See attached.
12. Chairs designating lanes for Lap Swimmers must be returned to the appropriate area.
13. All protocols/procedures must be followed, or we will be forced to close the pool.
